- b) A movement from a Baroque sonata or suite (e.g., G.B. Sammartini, H. Eccles, ...)
- c) A movement from a work of the Viennese Classical period (e.g., Concerto in D major, Hob. VIIb/4)
- d) A movement from a work of the Romantic period
- e) A movement from a work of the "Modern" period (e.g., P. Hindemith, Scherzo in G minor) The program must include both fast and slow movements, and at least three pieces must be performed from memory.

Bachelor's Degree in Instrumental Pedagogy (PBA)
